

NOTES

- WHEEL STOPS CANNOT STOP VEHICLES AND ONLY SERVE AS A SIGNAL TO DRIVERS THAT THEY SHOULD STOP TO PREVENT DAMAGING INFRASTRUCTURE OR INTRUDING INTO A PATH OF TRAVEL. USE BOLLARDS OR SIMILAR OBSTACLES WHERE PROTECTION IS REQUIRED.
- 2. WHEEL STOPS SHALL NOT BE INSTALLED IN ANY DESIGNATED OR INFORMAL PATH OF TRAVEL.
- 3. WHERE PARKING SPACE IS 11'-0" OR WIDER, INSTALL TWO WHEEL STOPS.
- 4. WHEEL STOPS SHALL BE PRECAST CONCRETE WITH A MINIMUM COMPRESSIVE STRENGTH OF 4,000 PSI AT 28 DAYS.
- 5. WHEEL STOPS SHALL BE REINFORCED WITH A MINIMUM OF TWO #4 DEFORMED BARS.
- 6. WHEEL STOPS SHALL HAVE A MIN OF TWO $\frac{3}{4}$ " DIA HOLES FOR ANCHORS, EXCEPT WHERE WHEEL STOPS ARE ADHERED TO CONCRETE PAVING PER NOTE 9 BELOW.
- 7. DIMENSIONS SHOWN ARE TYPICAL AND MAY BE SUPERSEDED BY SPECIFIC PROJECT REQUIREMENTS.
- 8. ANCHOR WHEEL STOPS WITH TWO 5%" DIA BY 24" LONG BARS. USE GALVANIZED OR EPOXY COATED ROUND BAR OR DEFORMED REBAR.
- 9. AT CONC PAVING, DRILL HOLES THROUGH CONCRETE FOR ANCHORS OR USE EPOXY ADHESIVE PER CALTRANS STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS 95-1.02E OR 95-1.02F.
- 10. WHEEL STOPS AT ADA PARKING SHALL BE PAINTED BLUE. USE WATER BASED LOW VOC TRAFFIC PAINT BY BENJAMIN MOORE, SHERWIN WILLIAMS, OR EQUAL.
