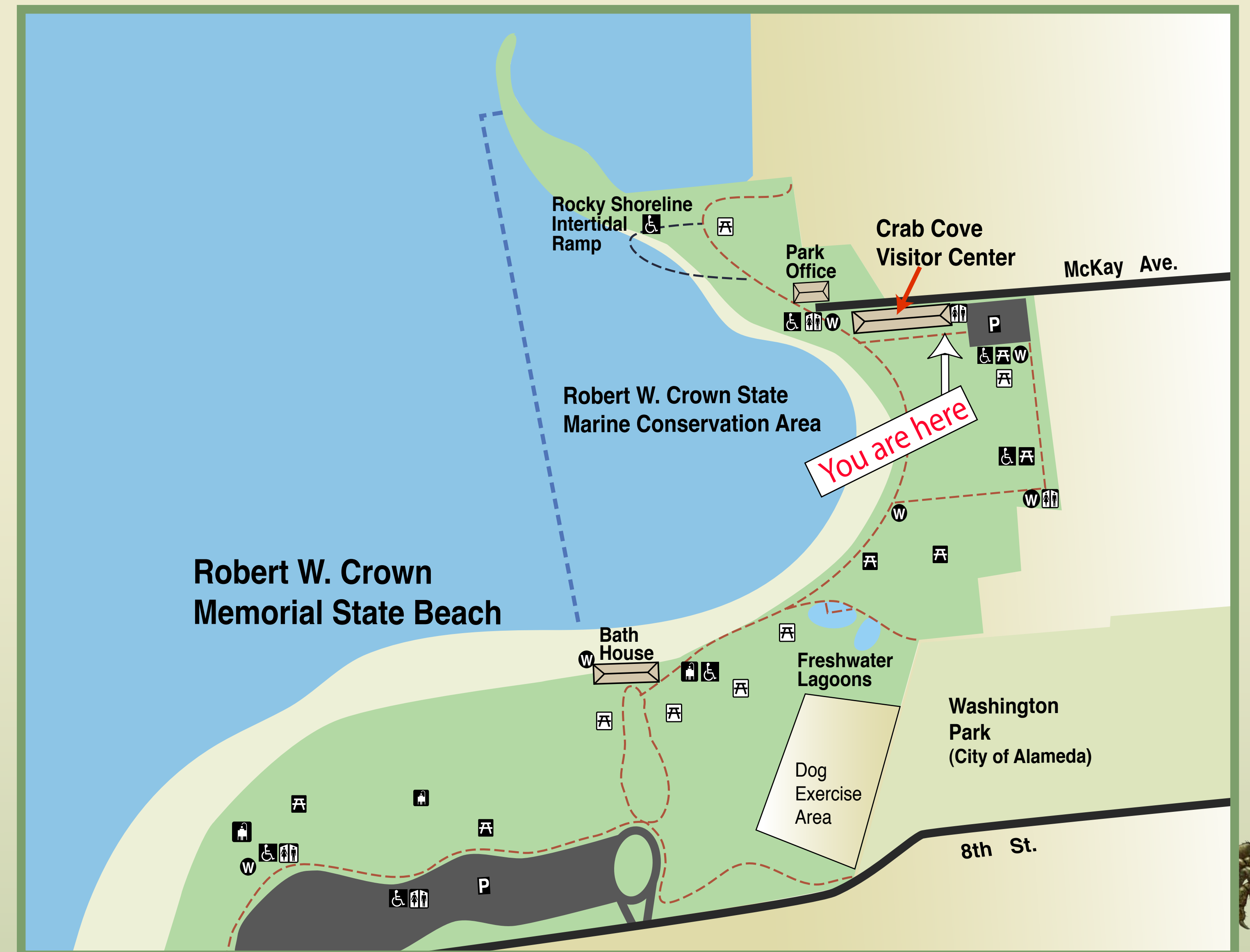


# Welcome to Robert W. Crown State Marine Conservation Area and Crab Cove Visitor Center









 Leave what you find: no collecting is permitted.

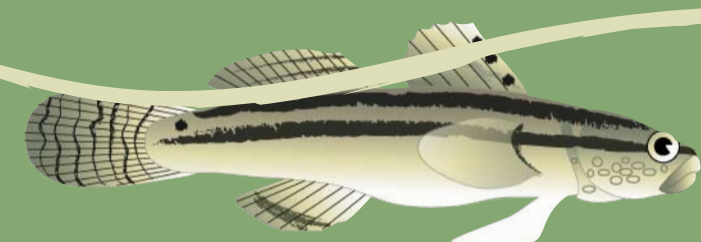
